Hawai'i Volcanoes Lexicon Detective

Overview:

As students navigate the "Hawai'i Volcanoes" unit of the *Ola Ka Honua: Volcanoes Alive* interactive DVD, they will toggle between the English and Hawaiian language versions to expand their knowledge of Hawaiian lexicon. Students will be asked to find the Hawaiian translation for specific English terms and phrases found on the interactive DVD. Scientific and cultural terms are included.

Objectives:

The student will improve Hawaiian Language fluency and understanding by identifying the Hawaiian translation for the following English terms and phrases found on interactive DVD: song/anthem or chant, Pacific Plate, stages, submarine, shield, capping, late, atoll, volcano growth, erosion, coral reef building.

Materials:

- Ola Ka Honua: Volcanoes Alive interactive DVD
- Student Worksheet: "Hawai'i Volcanoes Lexicon Detective"

Activity Procedure:

- 1. Distribute the *Ola Ka Honua: Volcanoes Alive* interactive DVD and the Student Worksheet: "Hawai'i Volcanoes Lexicon Detective."
- 2. Demonstrate how to toggle between English and Hawaiian on the interactive DVD.
- 3. Ask students to find the Hawaiian translations for each English word on the worksheet by using the translation toggle function on the interactive DVD.

- 7. late stage = e. ka pae lohi
- 8. atoll stage = i. ka pae moku kua'au
- 9. volcano growth = c. ka ulu lua pele
- 10. erosion = b. ka 'a'aiawā
- 11. coral reef building = h. ke kūkulu kohola
