Describing Earth's Atmosphere

Overview:

Students brainstorm and write a paragraph describing Earth's atmosphere. The paragraph includes a topic sentence, contains at least three supporting sentences and uses vocabulary terms.

Objectives:

The student will:

- brainstorm an idea using pictures and words;
- write and identify a topic sentence for a paragraph;
- write a complete paragraph with at least three supporting sentences; and
- demonstrate understanding of vocabulary words by using them in a paragraph.

Materials:

- Highlighters (one per person)
- Aurora Alive multimedia video playlist
- STUDENT WORKSHEET: "Describing Earth's Atmosphere"

Activity Procedure:

- 1. Ask students to review the interactive *Aurora Alive* playlist regarding Earth's atmosphere. Distribute highlighters and the STUDENT WORKSHEET: "Describing Earth's Atmosphere."
- 2. Ask students to draw Earth's atmosphere in the box provided on the worksheet. Include (and label) each of the items in the word bank.
- 3. Next, ask students to write a paragraph describing Earth's atmosphere. The paragraph should include a topic sentence and at least three supporting sentences. It must also include at least three words from the word bank.
- 4. When students have completed their paragraphs, ask them to highlight the topic sentence and the three words from the word bank before sharing the paragraph with a partner.

Answers to Student Worksheet:

- 1. Drawing depicts Earth's atmosphere and the word bank items are labeled.
- 2. The paragraph describes Earth's atmosphere in at least 4 sentences, including a topic sentence and at least 3 words from the word bank.
- 3. The topic sentence and 3 words from the word bank are highlighted in the paragraph.
